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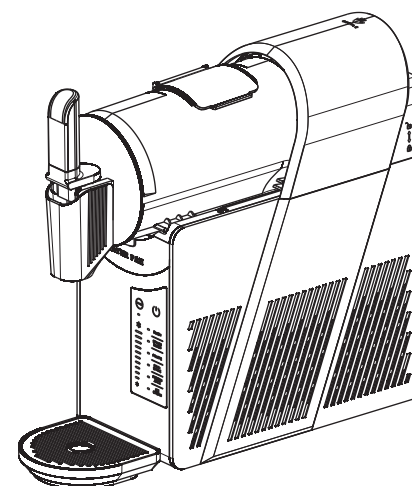

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Product Features

- Due to potential safety hazards under certain conditions, we strongly recommend not using extension cords.
- Do not crush or pull the power cord. The power cord should be placed where it will not be contacted and must not be immersed in water.
- This product shall not be used by persons with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge (including children), unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning the use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Do not plug in or unplug the power plug with wet hands.

- Do not add frozen fruits, frozen vegetables, or ice cubes to the running machine.
- Do not add hot ingredients.
- Do not fill the container beyond the maximum fill line. Closely supervise during use.

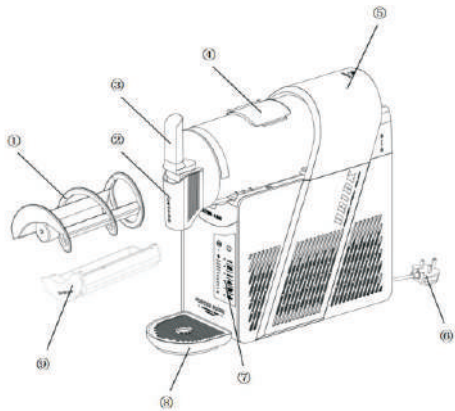
- Pay attention to the ingredient recipe. Sugar content must be above 10%, soda content above 16%, and alcohol (wine, beer, etc.) must be between 2.8% and 16% to avoid affecting the normal use and damaging the machine.
- The smoothie machine must not be placed upside down during transportation. The tilt angle shall not exceed 45 degrees. If the machine has tipped over, it is recommended to place it upright for 2 hours before switching it on.
- Install the machine in a place avoiding direct sunlight, with a flat, dry, dust-free, and well-ventilated surface (countertop). The ambient temperature should not be higher than 32°C and keep away from heat sources.

⚠ WARNING: The refrigerant used in the cooler is flammable.

Please follow the safety warnings below to reduce the risk of injury or property damage.

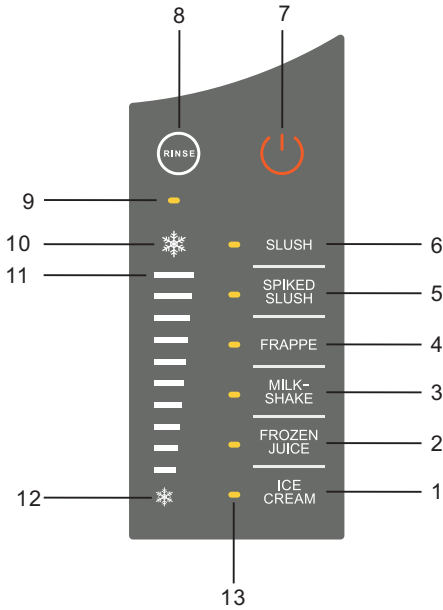
- Do not damage the refrigerant circuit during handling, installation, or operation.
- For repair services, please contact the manufacturer or qualified professional technicians.
- Leave a space of more than 150mm around the smoothie machine to ensure good ventilation.

Making Slush

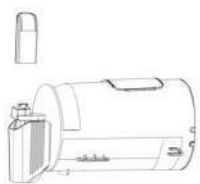
1. Machine Disassembly and Installation Operation:



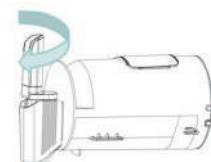
1). Check that all components are complete.



2). Assemble the drip tray, residual liquid box, and stirrer.

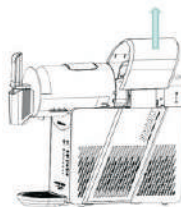

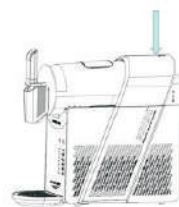

3). Install the ice barrel handle: As shown in Figure a, align it with the mounting holes and rotate clockwise to fix it in place, as shown in Figure b.

4). Install the ice barrel: As shown in Figure c, lift the buckle handle to its highest point, place the ice barrel along the guide rail to the innermost position, then press the buckle handle down until you hear a click, indicating installation is complete.

2. Slushie Machine Buttons

(1) Power Button

After installation is complete and the power is connected, the buzzer will beep once, and the machine enters standby mode. Press the button shortly, the machine defaults to the smoothie function, with the hardness level defaulting to level 5.

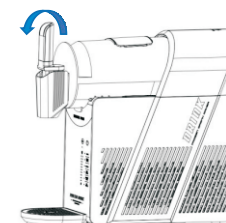
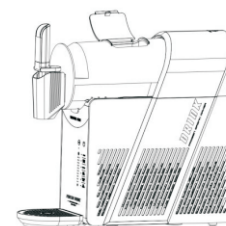
(2) Clean Button

When the machine is in standby mode, press the button shortly, the stirrer begins to rotate for cleaning. Pressing the button during mode operation has no response; it only runs in standby mode. Independent cleaning operation will automatically stop after 20 minutes of no operation.

(3) Beverage Modes

10 levels are available for selection. Each mode automatically corresponds to the best taste temperature. If adjustment is needed, press the Hardness Plus and Hardness Minus buttons shortly.

3. Slush Making Steps



1. Connect to power, open the top lid of the ice barrel, pour in an appropriate amount of liquid, then close the lid.

2. Press the power button shortly, select the desired mode to start making the beverage.
Note: The poured ingredients must reach the minimum scale line and be below the maximum scale line.
3. Place a cup on the tray, pull the handle down to dispense.
4. Release the handle, allowing it to reset to the closed position.

Sugar Standard

Please refer to the beverage/liquid nutrition label to ensure the sugar content meets the following recommended minimum requirements:

Amount of Ingredient Added	Minimum Sugar Content
8oz (240mL)	8g
12oz (355mL)	11g
20oz (591mL)	18g

Sugar-free substitutes and artificial sweeteners cannot replace the sugar requirement.

Alcohol Standard


Please refer to the beverage/liquid nutrition label to ensure the alcohol content meets the following recommended requirements:

Amount of Ingredient Added	Maximum Alcohol Content
24oz (710mL)	4oz (120mL)
36oz (1.06L)	6oz (180mL)
48oz (1.42L)	8oz (240mL)

During freezing, alcohol (wine, beer, etc.) must be between 2.8% and 16%.

Disassembly & Parts Cleaning

Using the Cleaning Cycle to Clean the Machine

- 1. Drain the remaining beverage from the ice barrel.
- 2. Add warm water up to the maximum scale line of the ice barrel.
- 3. Press the Clean button  , the stirrer will rotate.
- 4. After rotating for cleaning, drain the water from the barrel.
- 5. Repeat this operation 2-3 times until the frozen drink on the evaporator is washed away, indicating the cleaning is complete.
- 6. Turn off the machine.

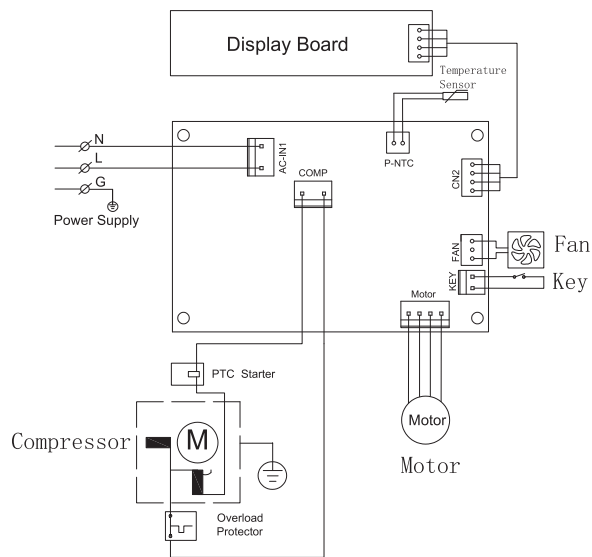
Disassembly for Cleaning

Note: Before disassembling for cleaning, confirm the power plug is disconnected to avoid electric shock.

- 1. Lift the buckle handle, then remove the ice barrel, stirrer, residual liquid box, and drip tray in sequence. Rinse them clean in the sink (Do not use water temperatures exceeding 80°C).
- 2. Wipe the evaporator and other dirty parts with a clean, warm, damp cloth.
- 3. Keep all parts dry.

Motor Protection Function: If the setting is too hard or ingredients are incorrect, the frozen drink may become increasingly hard, and the stirring motor may stall, which is normal. In this case, the motor protection device will automatically stop the motor to protect the stirring motor's lifespan.

Maintenance

- 1. After cleaning is completed, turn off the power and unplug the plug promptly.
- 2. After cleaning the parts, dry the surface with a clean, dry cloth before reassembly to prevent odor or mold growth.
- 3. When cleaning, be careful not to immerse the main body in water or pour water from the sides or back.

3	Level 7 LED Flashing	Low sugar alarm	Add sugar to ice barrel (Sugar : Solution = 1:8)
4	Level 8 LED Flashing	Ice barrel installation abnormal	Reinstall the ice barrel to the correct state
5	Level 9 LED Flashing	Ice jam alarm	Turn off the machine, wait for the ice to melt before restarting
6	Level 10 LED Flashing	NTC signal abnormal	Contact after-sales service
